Rate Increase

Effective October 1, 2026

The Municipal Authority of Buffalo Township (MABT) is committed to providing safe and reliable drinking water for our customers while managing costs of our operations.

Over the past several years, MABT has been able to absorb rising costs associated with supplies, materials, electricity, and regulatory requirements while meeting our debt obligations.

MABT has found it necessary to raise water user rates for our customers in the Buffalo Township service area, which will be accomplished through a two-tiered process. The minimum water user fee will increase \$1.00, plus the fee for additional water usage per 1,000 gallons will increase \$0.25, on October 1, 2026, and again on July 1, 2027. Therefore, a residential customer using 3,000 gallons per month with a ¾" short meter will pay \$27.75 instead of \$25.25 per month.

Our rate increase will help MABT meet financial obligations while ensuring the current level of service and commitment to providing safe, clean drinking water for our customers.
